SOME (VERY QUICK!) TIPS

GRANT WRITING TIPS

- Be prepared (typical copy, documents, costs, etc.)
- Be strategic (weighing your priorities with their priorities)
- Follow the **Project Development Process**
- Use **Concept Notes** to clarify and communicate your idea before tackling the application
- Use the “**Problem, Solution, Impact**” approach to communicate your idea
- Follow the principles of persuasive writing (active voice, assertive vocab, etc.)
- Communicate with the funder and be resilient

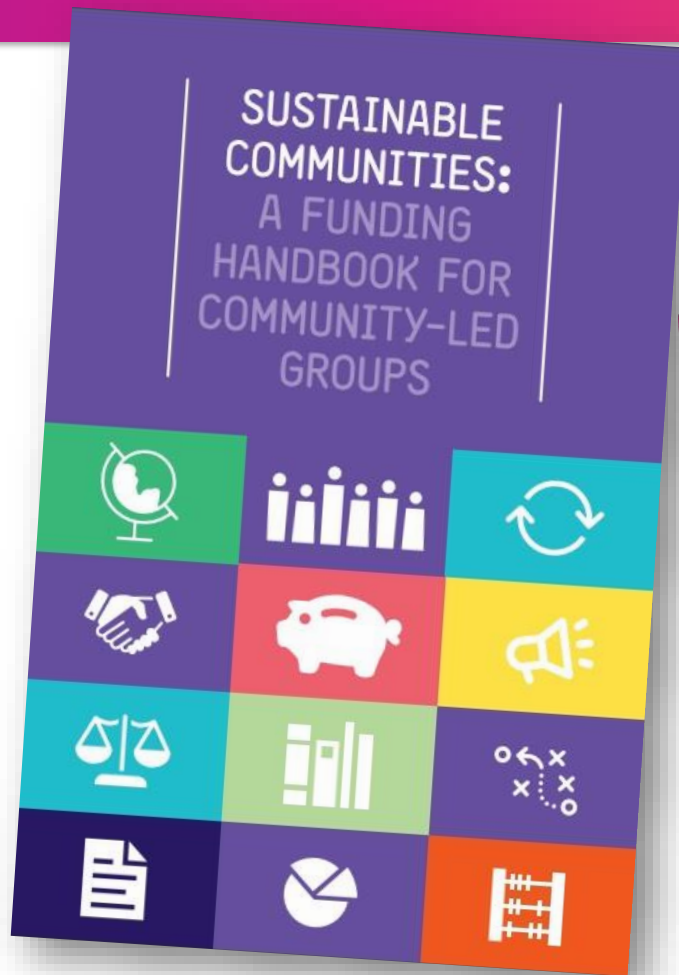

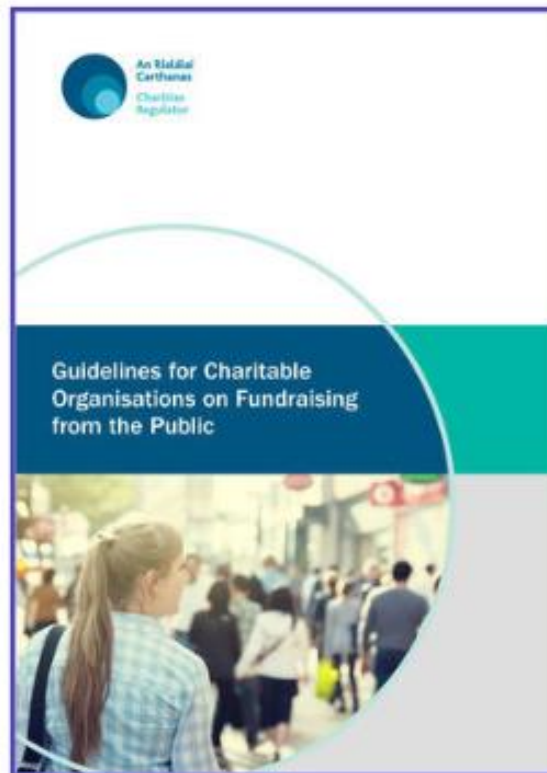
